## My Favorite Shortcuts

<b>G</b>	Library Grid view
<b>E</b>	Library Loupe view
<b>N</b>	Library Survey view
<b>D</b>	Develop Module
<b>Tab</b>	hides and reveals left and right panels
<b>Shift-Tab</b>	hides and reveals both the panels and filmstrip
<b>Ctl/Cmd Z:</b>	Undo last step (hit multiple times to go back multiple steps)
<b>Z</b>	Zooms in and out (Library and Develop)
<b>Ctl/Cmd +/-</b>	zooms in and out (Library and Develop)
Space bar	hand tool (Library and Develop)
<b>I</b>	display information about the image (hit once or twice to get different info) - Library and Dev.
<b>\</b>	grid view: hides and reveals the Library filter bar at the top.
<b>P, X, U</b>	Flags: Pick, Reject, Unflag
<b>0-5</b>	assign 0 to 5 stars to your image.
<b>6-9</b>	assign colors to your image.
<b>B</b>	assigns the selected image to the Quick Collection/ Target Collection
<b>T</b>	hides/reveals toolbar
<b>F</b>	Cycle screen modes (Full screen)
<b>L</b>	Lights Out
<b>Develop:</b>	
<b>R</b>	crop tool
<b>K</b>	adjustment brush
<b>O</b>	toggle on/off the adjustment brush overlay (shows where you have painted)
<b>N</b>	spot removal tool
<b>\</b>	toggle Before/After
<b>Y</b>	View before and after side by side
<b>X</b>	Rotate the crop frame
<b>Page Down:</b>	when you are zoomed in, page down will step through your image, top to bottom, left to right
<b>[, ]</b>	reduce, increase brush size (spot removal tool, red eye, and adjustment brush)
<b>Ctl/Cmd E</b>	Edit in Photoshop
